Opening:

- Dynamic Sign training will be held February 22 or 23rd. Sign Dan and Tony up for the 22nd. Town must attend the meeting in order to get the sign. If the town doesn't participate it will lose their opportunity and the next town will be selected.
- After reviewing an outdated charter from a local non-profit and the suggestion from the Town's Attorney, Selectmen will be asking Non-profits for updated information/charter, to be turned into the Town Assessor for review..
- A lease agreement is recommended with an entities using a town building. The Volunteer Food Pantry and the organization that uses the Horse rink will be asked to sign a lease agreement.
- Penny contacted A & D electric to shut the school flashing lights off. There are few lights in town that need a brighter light. The town can now get LED lights which will save money in the long run. At this time only 4 or 5 lights may be changed. These changes will occur at the intersection of Depot Rd. and Main St., Depot Rd. and Thorndike Rd. near Family Dollar, UHOP and the Food Pantry.
- Sherry Gray did not comply with the payment plan established by her and the Selectmen to obtain her property back. She indicated to the selectmen that she will get enough income tax money to pay for the back taxes. Tony feels she should pay it in full plus one year. Selectmen agree Sherry may have the property after paying all back taxes plus the estimated 2018 taxes.
