**Other Business:**

Auditor suggest that we don't carry forward balances, but rather the money go to surplus at the end of the fiscal year and then to raise funds out of surplus for the new fiscal year.

Penny suggested that an office policy needs to be established that all phone numbers are to asked for when accepting checks.

RSU #3 will have a special election May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Registered voters will vote to accept whether they approve a grant that was awarded to the district.
