Selectmen's Meeting
April 18, 2017

Opening:

Meeting opened at 6:35p.m.

People present were:

Selectmen: Penny S., Tony A., Emily Newell

Employee: Kari H.

Guests: Dan McCormick, David Schofield

Public Feedback: David Schofield states there is a failed septic system. David is going to call and ask to inspect. Would the home owner be eligible for grants?

Minutes: Change spring cleaning to its own item. Selectmen approved minutes with the change.

Treasurer:

Selectmen reviewed treasurer's report.

Discussed the TAN, and how much was in the current checking account. Selectmen and Treasurer signed the TAN.

Reviewed and signed warrants.

Old Business:

Emily will look into a Town spring cleanup.

Shed: Tony is getting quotes for the ground work.

Pedestrian signs: Amazon.com: \$175 - \$210, cheaper than sign companies. Tony is going to seek cheaper signs with DOT.

EDC: Motion to approve \$5,000 for the EDC to use for marketing. Tony approves the funds as long as it is used for 1 website and marketing video (which is already in the works). Penny suggested they look at the Town of Millinocket website. Penny would like to talk with the EDC, but still on the fence about issuing the money. Decision was tabled.

Job Description: Emily has drawn up a job description for a town handy man. The outline describes handy man work as well as road work. Possibly to have 2 people, one for the small stuff town stuff, (ex: replacing road signs and taking in and putting out the dock at the boat landing) and another as a road contractor.

New Business:

Appointment: Mark Babin was appointed as a member of the Budget Committee. Amiee Dorval declines the offer to be on the Budget Committee again.

A Unity Area Regional Recycle Center Representative is needed. Tony will ask someone he has in mind.

Penny is working on a Recreation Committee.

Earth Day Clean-up: UBR is hosting an Earth Day Clean up on April 21, it will be held at the Triplet Park.

Emily met with CMP and electricians about installing fixtures for lighted speed limit signs, the project was estimated to be \$10,000. We will sign up with DOT for the traveling speed limit sign.

A culvert is being intentionally blocked to help maintain pond levels. This is effecting the condition of the road. Selectmen will follow up with a few laws and possibly visit the landowner with the town Constables.

Selectmen will be meeting with Peter Melik Khoury from the Unity College at 6:30pm. During this meeting, the Selectmen would like to address the parking problem on Depot St during special events.
