Opening:

- Penny Sampson and Lucia Picard will be KVCOC's General Assembly Reps.
- Selectmen voted for two MMA Policy Committee.
- Selectmen met with Unity College Jim K. and Holly K. regarding parking near Founders Hall. Jim and Holly will address the issue.
- The electronic speed sign needs to be put up. Dan and Tony are going to look at which polls it can be hung on, but then look into a cheap trailer so the sign may be moved. Dan will check out the prices.
