#### New Business:

- Selectmen open the bids for Winter Plowing

Bidder 1: D. Starbird, \$174,988/year for 3 years.

Bidder 2: Roundy's: Year 1-\$5,551.47/mile Year 2: - \$5,829.04/mile Year 3:- \$6,120.49/mile based on 34 miles of road. Sand is 10.47/year in addition to plowing.

Bidder 3: Littlefield: Year 1: \$183,340 Year 2: \$185,000 Year 3: \$188,840.00
