

Minutes
Selectmen's Meeting
November 21, 2017

Opening:

Meeting opened at 6:30pm.

People present were:

Selectmen: Penny Sampson, Tony Avila

Employee: Kari Hunt

Guests: Dan McCormick & Jim Buckle

Public Feedback: Penny stated the county budget is up 5%

Minutes: Minutes from November 7, 2017 selectmen's meeting were passed.

Treasurer:

- Treasurer's warrants were reviewed and signed.
- Selectmen reviewed the town accounts.

Broadband: Jim Buckle would like to have the Selectmen talk with Unitel about their internet service or lack of. Jim believes Unitel charges for top end service and the consumer ends up with low quality. Businesses that depend on internet service have a hard time with the long lags and very slow service. He would like to know what other options we have.

New Business:

- Roads: Selectmen met with Jamie from All States. The culverts are still there, who is responsible for picking them up? Todd? Tony is to follow up with Jamie.
Cross Road sign is gone and pot hole is starting to go under the road, needs to be filled. Tony has a large chevron sign to put up there.
Farewell bridge needs repairs. Town has the beams to replace the rotting planks. Who will complete the work? Tony will contact Craig Brown and Ron Valles.
- Shed has a possible leak.
- TIF: An application for a loan was submitted in September. A decision has not been made. The committee keeps coming back saying they need more information. The applicant was told that December was a hard time to get people

together, the a meeting should be scheduled for the first of the year. Penny stated that the process should only take 30 days, not 3 - 4 months.

- Funds for UBx Festival: Selectmen voted to reimburse UBx up to \$300 from TIF for lights.
- Penny has asked that businesses light up Unity this holiday season. Should the town buy lights and give them to business?
- Tony would like to find out what it takes to get inmates in town to clean sidewalks, tree removal, etc.... Contact local sheriff's office.

Other Business:

- The new 25 mph signs are up on Quaker Hill Rd. The signs certainly can not be missed. A bill for the signs will be sent to Unity College, they said they would reimburse the town for the signs.
