Opening:

Public Feedback:**Treasurer:**

- Warrants were reviewed and signed.
- Tax bills were sent out.
- TAN must be paid by 01/31.

Old Business:

- The Firehouse has not been painted yet, only pressure washed. Contractor has until August 31, 2018 to finish it.
- Selectmen suggest the Fire Department ask MOFGA for \$2,160 for Fire Protection during Common Ground Fair. This figure is based on 5 men, 3 days, 12 hr/days.

New Business:

- Selectmen cast their ballot for the Waldo County Budget Committee.
- Selectmen vote to no participate this year in the Household Hazardous Waste program through KVCOG. It cost more to the town, than the number of people that take advantage of it.
- Selectmen sign Excise Tax Agreement with the Town of Troy. This allows the town of Unity to complete vehicle registrations for Troy in the event Troy Town Clerk is unable to process Vehicle Registrations.
- Selectmen reviewed and signed the agreement with GovOffice to transition our website to a responsive design.
