Public Feedback:

Does the town have a Spring Clean-up day? It stopped several years ago because it was costing \$8,000 to \$10,000/year.

There is a fox running around town, there have been complaints about it looking sick. It has mange. Game Wardens and ACO will not handle it.

Minutes: Minutes from May 19, 2020 were reviewed and approved by the Selectmen..

Treasurer:

- Warrants were reviewed and signed
- An Excise Tax Agreement with Thorndike was signed.

Administrative Assistant:

- Received a building application, it was denied, we do waive the fee. Selectmen approve to waive the fee. The applicant will need to go to the appeals board and pay the appropriate fee.

Old Business:

- Tanker: Triple M did not build the cradle that supports the Tank, originally camp from PA. The cradle does not hold the tank properly. Reliance is getting a quote to refab the cradle. At this point we are awaiting a quote of Reliance.
- Penny has completed the neckdowns with the help of Pam. and Kanokolus is looking good.

New Business:

- There needs to be more members on the EDC. Tony was elected at Chair and Larry King does not want to rejoin.
- Selectmen sign an agreement to receive a RRFB sign from the State of Maine. Ideally this will be placed on Main St. across from UHOP.
- Horse Ring: Kathy has asked if she can hold horse shows. Selectmen agree, but they must maintain 50 people and if the show goes over 50 people then the Selectmen will shut the horse shows down.
- Rich Road: A resident has asked that Sullivan's, Plowing and other equipment related to town business not use their land, they don't receive any tax breaks and Sullivan's wouldn't pick up their trash without stickers. The Wilson's have agreed to allow the town equipment to turn around on their property. Tony and Dan will take a look and be sure to contact the businesses that will need to know the new spot to turn around.
- Road signs: Libby Hill: Deadend, Kanokolus, Slow, Children at Play, Hunter Rd, Stop Sign, Rich Rd, the ditch needs work, Ward Hill Rd, Street Sign. Call Michael and give list.
- Contact Ed to fix the cement pathway in front of the town office by bringing gravel in the fix the transition front cement to parking lot.
- Fire Department: Hose testing was done for the year.
- CMP pole permits were signed.

- Fire Department ordered PPE equipment.
- Tony will call the painter that painted the fire house. Not impressed with the lack professionalism in the job, and repairs that need to be done.
- Blaine found spare shingles for the Fire Department, Troy Reynold volunteered his time to fix the roof. Thank you Troy Reynolds
