Penny will apply for grants available through MMA for Fire Equipment. She asked Blaine to send pictures of equipment that needs replacing.

**New Business:**

- CMP has install most of the LED lights in the town. There are few more to install. Should be seeing brighter lights through town.
- Park and Rec asked if the letter they submitted for the Community Day at the Field of Dreams was discussed with Unity College and the outcome. They thought it was a great idea, but participants would need to sign a waiver and they would need to know in advance. Denise discussed a few fundraising ideas they had for this year. Denise and Najean are not available for Town Meeting to put on the lunch, they recruited Cindy Jones and Peggy Turner to help. Lunch will be \$7.00 and a dessert auction will be held after.
- Received a quote from ProSeal for a pallet of crack seal, it is approximately \$4,300. Selectmen agree to get a pallet. ProSeal will take back what was not used.
- Tony will call Toby Farrington about grading roads this year.
