Penny opened the meeting at 6:30pm.

Minutes:

Penny made a motion to accept the minutes from 05/31/2022 with corrections. Tim seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Administrative Assistant/Treasurer:

- Warrants were reviewed and signed by the Select Board.
- Town pump is having issues, Dan was at the pump location, Tanner Grant has been called to hopefully resolved the issue. Dan suggested that the pump house door have a padlock installed. Equipment was tampered, causing the issues. Bill will be about \$100. Selectmen would like to meet with all the users to discuss future ownership of the pump on June 21, 2022.

Old Business:

- Penny called the State inspector to review the Farwell Bridge.

New Business:

- Fee permits for Driveway, Lot Permit and Road are still \$20.00. Penny made a motion to increase the fee to \$25. Dan seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- Penny read a request to study eagles on town property. Penny requested a copy of the State and Federal permit for town records Penny made a motion for the Biodiversity Research Institute to study the eagles on Town Property. Dan seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- Selectmen to work on a list of roads that need to be crack sealed. Approximately \$55,000 has been spent on town road work and still more work needs to be completed. Grading and striping are done, waiting on having the calcium spread.
- Maine Gravesite Maintenance will be in town. This year they are doing \$2,000 worth of work. There are a couple fallen stones in Pond Cemetery they are going to reset. Penny

stated much needed tree work will be done with the extra funds. Tim and Penny worked a little in Farwell.

- Blaine needs a copy of the warrant, bill and check to finalize the Forestry Grant.
- The Fire Department was awarded the MMA risk management grant. $\frac{1}{3}$ - $\frac{2}{3}$ grant. Town needing to pay $\frac{1}{3}$ risk management will pay $\frac{2}{3}$ cost.
- The Senior Parade will be June 11, 2022, the seniors will be walking from the Fire Department to the Field of Dreams.
- With upcoming parades and the rise of fuel, Penny requested that a smaller fire be used in out of town parades.
