## Selectmen's Meeting

### October 15, 2019

#### Opening:

Meeting opened at 6:35pm.

**Minutes:** Minutes from the October 1st were reviewed and accepted.

#### Public Feedback:

Michael Berry would like the Selectmen to address with the assessing company their lack of following through with a request to reassess his home. He also expressed concerned about the valuation of his home. Michael has made a few appointments with the assessor. The first he missed, the second the assessor called him, but told him the regular assessor would have to look into the following month. Selectmen will contact the assessor and request that he make it to Michael's and revalue his property. Michael has requested his homestead exemption. Selectmen will talk with the assessor.

#### Treasurer:

- Warrants were reviewed and signed.
- Selectmen approve to establish an amazon buy now pay later account.
- Thorndike Trail Blazers was issued a check in the amount of \$709.77, the check is lostt. Selectmen approve to stop payment and issue a new check.
- Fire Department submitted bill after the warrant was issued, Selectmen authorized to add the bills to the current warrant.
- Washington County Historical Society has acquired some cemetery records on Unity Cemeteries. They will send them if we are interested, they ask that we pay for postage, and shouldn't be more then \$2.75. Selectmen authorize having records sent.
- Contacted Sullivan's about the rate they are charging for the dumpster accounts, they have corrected the error and have credit us the difference.

#### Old Business:

- Penny contacted Bolster's to rent a dumpster to clean up the debris at the Horse Ring and the town office. \$190 for 5 days and \$90/ton. Will call to see if they can deliver Monday. Woodsmen team will pick the debris up.

#### New Business:

- There is a cemetery lot that the lot is exposed. Mike put some gravel down to cover it up. Who is responsible for putting the gavel down? Land owner or Town? More research will need to be done. The vault is exposed is due to ledge in the ground and was unable to dig the lot deep enough.
- The stop sign on Clark Road has to go in the barrel. There is no way to put the ground, there is much ledge.
- Need to schedule the annual service for the boiler. Will contact Waldo County Oil.

- Park and Rec: Thinking about hot dogs, rolls, etc for the Yuletide Festival, how does the Park and Rec purchase without an individual paying for it. It has also been expressed that one person can not do all the work and is getting burned out and does not want to attend the event. Selectmen agree that the Park and Rec doesn't need to attend the Yuletide.
