New Business:

Fire Dept:

Ladder truck is out of service. Cylinder head cracked and looking at all options. What do the Selectmen want to do with the truck? Selectmen want to table discussion to figure out how they want to proceed. Blaine wants to apply for a FEMA grant to help with the cost of a new truck.

Engine 9 will be going to Reliance for a pump issue.

Blaine inventoried radios and pagers, there is a need for pagers than radios. Applying for a grant for pagers and a couple radios with MMA risk management.

Blaine is looking to purchasing turn out gear from Bergeron. It is about the same cost as other places, but offers a 10 year warranty. He may purchase 1 or 2 sets this year.

SCBA have been ordered. Is expected to come in November.

Common Ground Fair went well, ended up staying an hour later Friday and Saturday and a couple hours longer on Sunday. This year contract was approximately \$3,000 and the contract was adjusted accordingly.

The Fire Association will buying surveillance cameras. They have noticed a bit more traffic going around the fire house.
