Selectmen's Meeting

October 2, 2018

Opening:

Meeting opened at 6:30pm.

Minutes: Minutes from September 18th were reviewed and approved pending changes.

Public Feedback:

Fire Department:

- Emily is not longer acting as the Administrative Assistant to the Fire Chief, Melissa has been completing the tasks and Blaine would like to pay Melissa for working in the third quarter. Selectmen approve paying Melissa.
- Fire Tech & Safety will be coming out to measure for 3 sets of turnout gear. Cost is approximately \$6,000. Turnout gear should be rotated every 10 years.
- Rescue 5 will be taken to Reliance Equipment, for air line leak and hydraulic issues.
- 8 Firefighters have passed EVOC training, 3 FF will be attending Central Maine Fire School and 2 will be taking basic pump training.
- Forestry grant is due in October, Blaine is completing the application.
- Blaine would like to work with the Unity College to apply \$100 on tuition for fire protection. Then in turn the funds would be placed into a Truck Replacement Fund. Selectmen would like to work on an False Alarm Ordinance. Any communication with the College is to go through the Selectmen. Selectmen will mention it at their next meeting with Melik, meeting is to be determined.
- Park and Rec can store the equipment in the trailer behind the Fire Station, however the equipment should be placed in lockable containers so nothing is stolen or damaged.

Treasurer:

- Warrants were reviewed and signed.
- Town of Unity will be receiving \$35,620.12 for the Salt/Sand Shed reimbursement.
